Take the time to check-out your motorcycles condition & the MSF T-clock check list is a valuable tool to ensure a safer enjoyable ride.

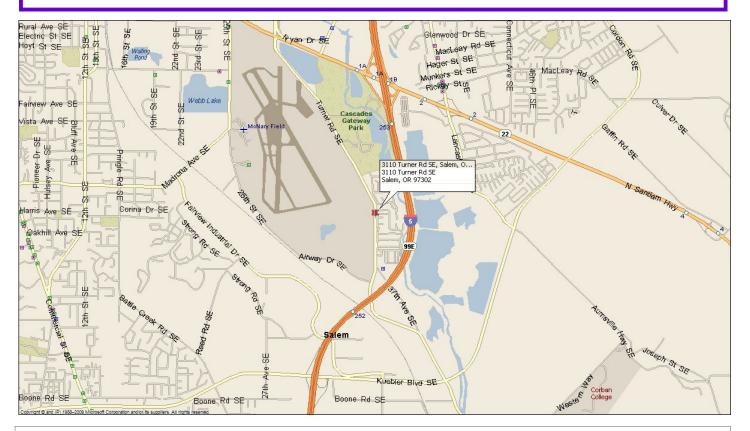
