## Is Your Motorcycle Ready For Chapter I's Blarney Ride This Month?

Some of you have been riding your motorcycle on the clear dry days that we have had this very mild winter. Others are waiting for a special one day ride, like Chapter I's Blarney ride on March 17th. Whether you have been riding all along or getting ready for that one special one day ride—remember to take time for t-clock. Take the time to check-out your motorcycles condition & the MSF T-clock check list is a valuable tool to ensure a safer enjoyable ride.

### T-CLOCS<sup>SM</sup> Inspection Checklist
